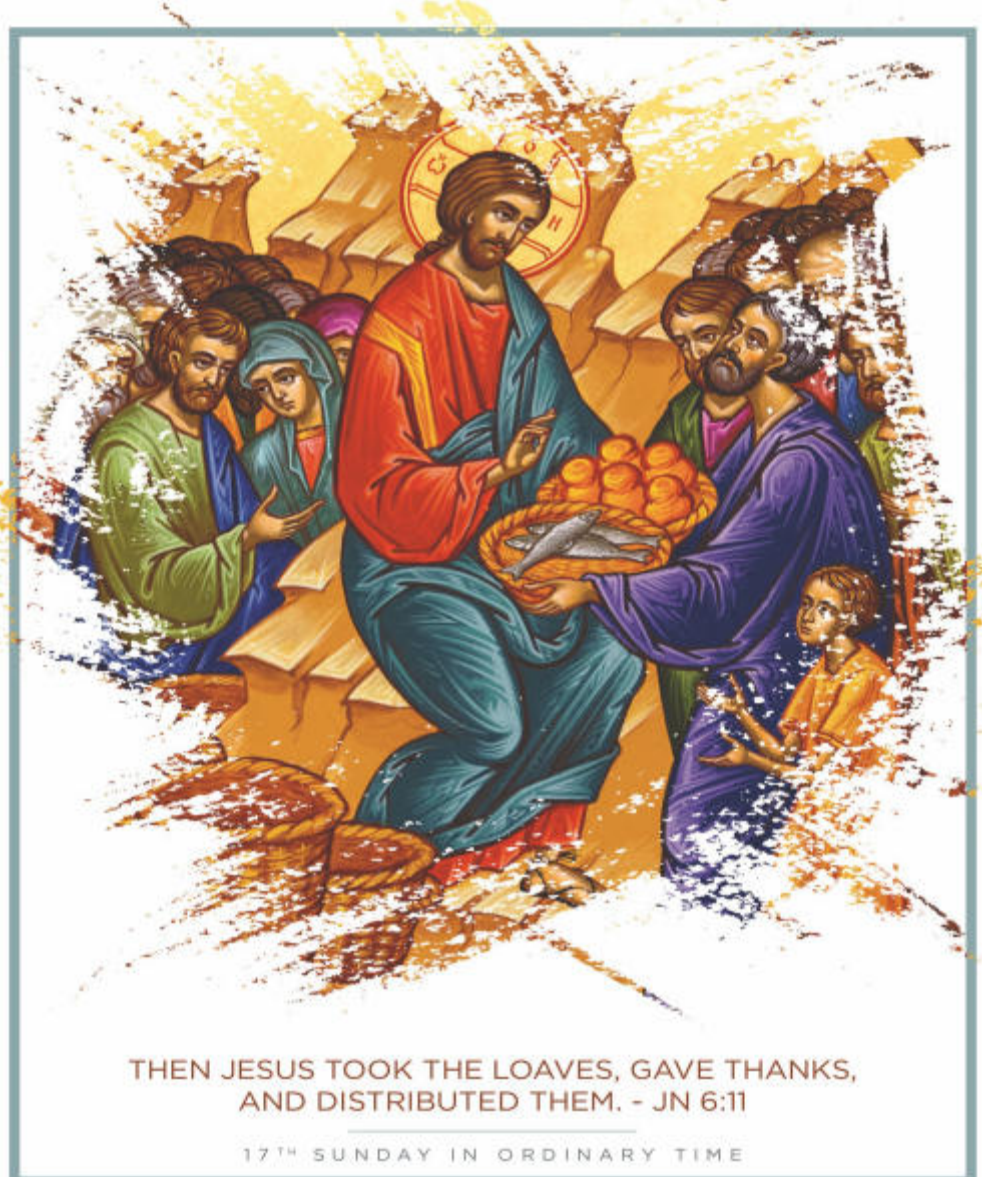

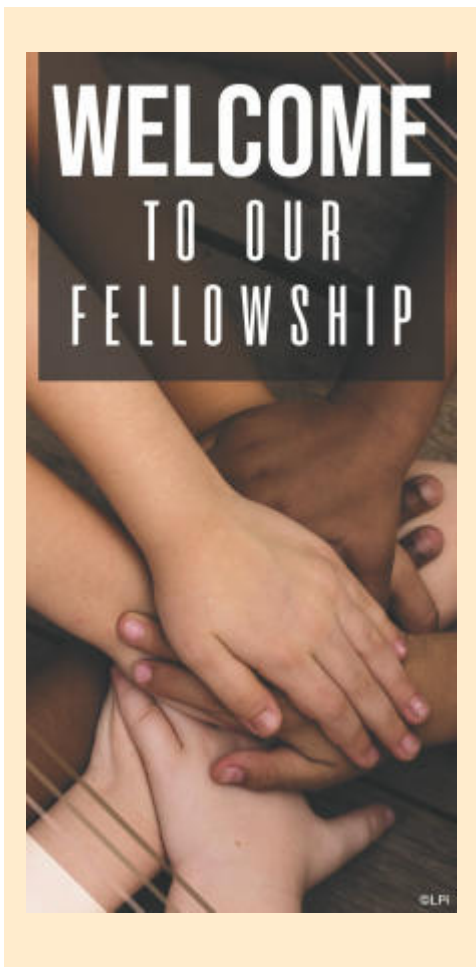
## From the deacon's chair...

In the early weeks of the pandemic, there was a growing need to provide food to those who lost jobs or whose employment hours were cut. The good work of the food pantry, the Siena House, and the ongoing ministry of the Saint Francis Catholic Kitchen showed how this parish family responds in a crisis. I am heartened to see what people were willing to do for one another in the name of Christ. When people begin to tell the story of the Covid-19 pandemic, I pray that Santa Cruz will remember how our parish responded. And yet, if it is soon forgotten, then it is only because people have come to expect good things from Holy Cross.

I know firsthand how you have helped the hungry of Santa Cruz.

I was poor in my youth and I happily supped at Saint Francis when things were hard. There I had my fill of soup, salad, and bread while sitting elbow to elbow with those whom Jesus called “blessed” in the beatitudes. Much of my diaconal ministry is attempting to repay what others had given me in my youth. If today I am Catholic, let alone clergy, it is because you fed me and prayed with me when all I had were needs and promises.

This weekend, we hear how Jesus not only healed the sick and proclaimed the kingdom of God, but that he fed the large crowd that came to him and his disciples. We hear how the hungry recognized him precisely because he had fed them. He still feeds us today. He feeds us both through the volunteers in our food ministries and through his presence in the Eucharist. As Catholics, we gather on Sundays because the Eucharist is the center of our lives and it is our spiritual nourishment. This week, I pray that we remain a Eucharistic people: both receiving Christ at Mass on Sunday and then sharing Christ throughout the week in our service to others.

## Desde la silla del diácono ...

En las primeras semanas de la pandemia, hubo una creciente necesidad de proporcionar alimentos a quienes perdieron el trabajo o cuyas horas de trabajo fueron recortadas. El buen trabajo de la despensa de alimentos, la Casa Siena y el ministerio continuo de la Cocina Católica de San Francisco mostraron cómo esta familia parroquial responde en una crisis. Me alienta ver lo que la gente estaba dispuesta a hacer unos por otros en el nombre de Cristo. Cuando la gente comenzó a contar la historia de la pandemia de Covid-19, oró para que Santa Cruz recuerde cómo respondió nuestra parroquia. Y, sin embargo, si se olvida pronto, es solo porque la gente ha llegado a esperar cosas buenas de Santa Cruz.

Sé de primera mano cómo has ayudado a los hambrientos de Santa Cruz.

Yo era pobre en mi juventud y felizmente cenaba en San Francisco cuando las cosas estaban difíciles. Allí me harté de sopa, ensalada y pan mientras me sentaba codo con codo con aquellos a quienes Jesús llamó "bienaventurados" en las bienaventuranzas. Gran parte de mi ministerio diaconal está intentando devolver lo que otros me habían dado en mi juventud. Si hoy soy católico, y mucho menos clérigo, es porque me alimentaste y oraste conmigo cuando todo lo que tenía eran necesidades y promesas.

Este fin de semana, escuchamos cómo Jesús no sólo sanó a los enfermos y proclamó el reino de Dios, sino que alimentó a la gran multitud que acudió a él y a sus discípulos. Escuchamos cómo los hambrientos lo reconocieron precisamente porque los había alimentado. Todavía nos alimenta hoy. Nos alimenta tanto a través de los voluntarios en nuestros ministerios de alimentación como a través de su presencia en la Eucaristía. Como católicos, nos reunimos los domingos porque la Eucaristía es el centro de nuestras vidas y es nuestro alimento espiritual. Esta semana, oró para que sigamos siendo un pueblo eucarístico: ambos recibiendo a Cristo en la Misa el domingo y luego compartiendo a Cristo durante la semana en nuestro servicio a los demás.

### Celebrating Lay Ministry of Catechists in the Church

On May 11, 2021, Pope Francis in his apostolic letter "Antiquum Ministerium ("Ancient Ministry") established the lay ministry of catechist in the Catholic Church. Pope Francis explained that it gives "recognition" to "those lay men and women who feel called by virtue of their baptism to cooperate in the work of catechesis." "The history of evangelization over the past two millennia shows the effectiveness of the mission of catechist" the pope said, among whom were "countless lay men and women," including many "saints and martyrs." Today, too, Pope Francis said, "many competent and dedicated catechists are community leaders in various parts of the world and carry out a mission invaluable for the transmission and growth of the faith." In April, May, and June, we witnessed as 41 candidates for First Communion received the sacrament for the first time. In May, 22 young adults were confirmed. During the past months of children's faith formation in preparation for the sacraments, particularly during the challenging times of meeting virtually, the priests, staff, parents, and catechists found creative ways to engage the candidates in ways that did not devalue the goal of faith formation. Let us celebrate our Holy Cross Catechists who served during this pandemic period - Elizabeth Borges, Claudia Manrique, Margaret O'Shea, Erin Wong, Vince & Joyce Lieggi, Maria & Francisco Leon, Jorge Salva, Kathy Elmore, and Phil Hodsdon.

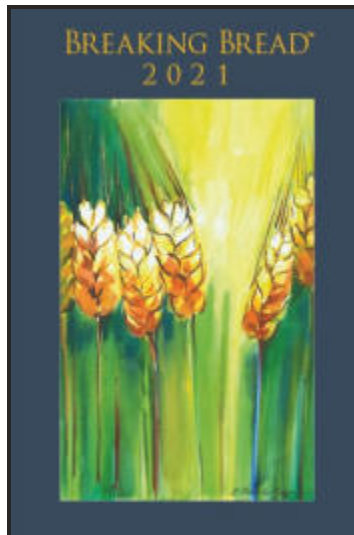
